Dear Parish Family,

After a ferocious storm that left most of us without power and many still without power this week, we hear the Calming of the Storm on the Sea of Galilee, how appropriate.

This account can be found in three of the four Gospels, Matthew, Mark and John. Luke does not record this momentous event maybe, like us, he would rather forget it! Mark and John have a slightly different account than Matthew with Jesus asleep in the boat. Matthew has Jesus on the water. Matthew's account has Jesus on the shore walking on the water toward the Apostles who are frightened. This must have been a beast of a storm, much like the one we just experienced, since the Apostles were mostly fishermen on this Sea who were familiar with the erratic storms that come fast on the Galilee.

There are some terrific paintings of this subject by some great masters of painting including; Christ at the Sea of Galilee by Tintoretto (now attributed to one of his students) at the National Gallery in Washington, DC and Rembrandt's "Christ in the storm at the sea of Galilee" from the Elizabeth Gardner Museum in Boston. Tintoretto's more closely follows Matthew's account where Jesus is in the foreground walking on the water toward the boat as Peter lifts his leg over the side of the boat to move toward him. Rembrandt's more closely follows Mark and John where Jesus is in the boat with the disciples asleep. However, a close examination of Tintoretto's has Jesus both on the shore and in the boat. Jesus is both with us in the storm and walking toward us in the storm assuring us. Rembrandt's image though, captures the tempest like no other painting. His usually serene style gives way to a dramatic violent storm, the type that are not related to weather, but to life. Because this is precisely the Gospel writers, Matthew, Mark and John's message, this is not about natural phenomena but about the storms of life. To drive that message home Rembrandt not only has Jesus and the disciples in the boat but he has painted himself into the story. He stands on the edge of the boat with one hand holding his cap so the wind doesn't take it and the other hand holding a rope, looking out at the viewer as frightened as the Apostles in the painting.

Rembrandt knows the struggles and tempests of life and places himself in the scene and wants us to place ourselves in the scene as well. He has one apostle trimming the sail, three others diligently attending to the mast, St. Peter holding the rudder steady (the boat being an image for the Church and Peter being the helmsman), one apostle is leaning over the boat about to vomit, some more plead with Jesus, only one apostle kneeling before Jesus in prayer and Rembrandt rewards his faith with a halo, the only halo in the scene! What faith this singular apostle with the halo has, which is exactly what Jesus is calling for in the passage.

The poor apostles in Matthew's account have been hanging on through a violent storm all alone for three of the four watches of the night. Somewhere around 6am during the fourth watch of the night, just as the sun is about to rise, Jesus appears on the water walking toward them. They are exasperated, exhausted and ready to die. At the moment Jesus appears, they are filled with fear and struck with terror when seeing Jesus they shout "It is a ghost"? Totally incredulous. the Lord of heaven and earth, the commander of wind and sea, replies, "Take courage, it is I, do not be afraid". Peter shouts over the wind that if Jesus commands, he will come, Jesus bids Peter "Come". The same "come" Peter heard when he abandoned his nets on the shore of a calmer sea to follow Jesus and be his princely apostle. How easy it is to "come" when the wind is calm, the sky sunny and not a cloud is on the horizon.

As Peter moves toward Jesus, he sees the strength of the wind and begins to sink. He thinks the wind more powerful than the one who created and commands it! Jesus commands, "you of little faith" and extends his hand to save Peter. The other Apostles, certainly glad it was not them in the water, and seeing the Lord tame the storm all acclaim "Truly, you are the Son of God".

Ask yourself after a very trying stormy week, in an age of civil unrest and amid a pandemic, which disciple are you in the boat? Are you the one trimming the sails, working the mast, holding firm the rudder, vomiting over the side, begging the Lord, holding your cap and rope staring out at the viewer or are you the one kneeling in prayer with the halo? Are you the one of boldly stepping out onto the water, or the one who thinks the wind greater than the commander and starting to sink? Are you the one sinking but accepting the helping hand the Lord extends in His great mercy? Think about it, maybe you are all of these at some point in life. Where ever you are in this story, where ever your story is now stormy or calm; the Lord is with you in the storm and on the shore, walking toward you with his open hand to lift you and calm the tempest. You need only reply, "Truly, you are the Son of God." He is there with you with assurance and calm.
