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St. Aloysius Music Ministry Fees



When planning your wedding, keep in mind that the music selection and the participation of the various musicians which we are able to provide for you play a significant role in your special day.

- Pricing includes the services of the organist as well as the soloist/cantor. All Nuptial Wedding Masses must select a cantor/soloist to sing for your wedding Mass. Every attempt will be made to provide you with your first choice of cantor selected. In the event, that the selected cantor is not available, we request that you also provide an alternate cantor choice on your music selection sheet.
- **N**UPTIAL **W**EDDING **C**EREMONIES

Couples who are getting married in a Nuptial Ceremony have two pricing options available to them when planning the music for their special day:

OPTION **#1 - O**RGANIST **W**ITH **S**OLOIST**\$300**

Couples have the opportunity of selecting soloists/cantors as well as other musicians to enhance your wedding day experience. The use of a cantor/soloist is optional for Wedding Ceremonies.

OPTION #2 - ORGANIST ONLY WITH LIMITED VOCAL SELECTIONS \$250

If you choose not to use a soloist, the organist will play primarily instrumental prelude selections and will provide limited vocals for the responsorial psalm & gospel acclamation.

SELECTION OF ADDITIONAL MUSICIANS

We are fortunate at St. Aloysius Parish to be able to provide you with additional accompanying musicians to enhance your wedding experience including those who will play the trumpet/coronet, guitar, violin and/or flute. ALL MUSICIAN FEES ARE TO BE PAID ONE MONTH PRIOR TO THE WEDDING.

Note: Each hired musician must receive a separate check. For example: if you are having a cantor and organist participating in your wedding liturgy, you will need to send two separate checks for payment. One check would be for the organist's fee. A separate check would be made out for the soloist. We can provide you with the proper spelling for the soloist's name to insert on the check.

You may include guest musicians within your wedding ceremony/Mass. However, the guest musician must be an experienced musician who is comfortable with the traditions of a Catholic Wedding ceremony and who can provide a professional level of musicality for your wedding. The Music Director at St. Aloysius reserves the right to determine if the guest musician's level of experience is appropriate.

To ensure that the music provided by the guest musician selected for your wedding day meets the standards established by St. Aloysius Music ministry, all guest musicians will be required to attend a mandatory rehearsal session prior to the day of the wedding.

Due to the advanced technology and musical equipment being used in our new church facility, all Weddings (both Nuptial Masses & Nuptial Ceremonies) require the services of our Music Director to engineer the sound technology during your wedding. In the event that outside accompanists or organists are requested, the Fee for the Music Director is \$50.



MUSIC SELECTIONS



We have a variety of sacred liturgical music as well as classical selections from which you can choose for your special day. In addition to any of the hymns/musical selections listed below, you can also include music selections from our "Breaking Bread" hymnal which we use as our music supplement for the congregation.

All music selections contained on this listing are already approved for use. Any other selections must be reviewed for appropriateness and approved by the Director of Music before they can be included within your Wedding Ceremony or Nuptial Mass.

As you will note below, the selections can be used in several different areas throughout the Nuptial Mass or Ceremony. Refer to your Wedding Planning Information Sheet within this packet to see what areas of the Mass or Ceremony will include musical selections.

All of the cantors/soloists who have participated within the wedding workshop are able to sing the selections contained within this listing of music options.

Music will be played using the organ and the piano. Some selections are better suited to one instrument rather than another. Another component that comes into play regarding instrument selection is dependent upon whether you will be incorporating the violinist, harp or trumpet accompanists within your wedding. We want to ensure that you capitalize upon the richness that the additional musicians bring into your liturgy.

Note: Instrumental and Vocal Selections marked with a "**" are noted to indicate that those pieces are generally played using a piano accompaniment.
