Dear Parish Family-



The re-roofing of the new Church has continued into the new year due to supply chain issues. There have been a few minor leaks due to seam issues which have been corrected. The outside beams have been double wrapped and aluminum coping secured over them with scuppers at the end of the valleys to direct water away from the building. The rails you see around the entire roof are snow guards to break snow and ice as it comes down the steep slopes of the building. The snow or ice hits them, breaking into ever smaller pieces, to avoid damaging the roof. This was a problem with the old standing seam metal roof, it had no snow guards and snow/ice would fly down at a high velocity, taking parts of the roof off with it. Snow and ice can really cause a lot of damage on a roof. The snow guards help to lessen this problem. Our roof is very steep, plus it has constant motion. The extreme movement of the 'sails' on the front and back of the roof proved challenging for the roof workers. Due to the delays, funerals and daily Mass continue in Gonzaga Chapel during the week until further notice.

The new doors on the building required 5 different trades: an architect, the door manufacturer and installer, Baut Studios, an electrician, a handicap mechanism company and, a door security company. Due to supply chain issues, there was a delay in getting the handicap door up and running, but all eight doors are now operational, including the handicap door.

Are you sensing a theme here? "Covid Related Supply Chain Issues". So like the roof and the door project, our envelope company informed us in December that our 2024 envelopes would not arrive until the end of January due to "Covid Related Supply Chain Issues"!!! I am getting used to this answer to all modern problems! There are a lot of supply chain issues these days!

Thank you to everyone who sent a card, gift, food, wine, dinner, etc. to our priests for Christmas. We really appreciate your kindness. There were a few gifts that did not have cards, so we did not know who to thank. So, thank you for the delicious half sheet homemade crumb cake which was devoured within days and, for the beautifully decorated smores cookie and caramel nut cookie tray in the cute cups.

Sacrament of ANOINTING OF THE SICK

In the Catholic Church, the anointing of the sick is a sacrament that is administered to a Catholic "who, having reached the age of reason, begins to be in danger due to sickness or old age". There is no need to wait until a person is at the point of death to receive the Sacrament. The Sacrament may be received at any time during a person's illness, especially before surgery or treatment. We suggest calling to receive the Sacrament *before* a person is in grave danger of death as it is not always possible to have a priest available at the actual time of death. If you would like to schedule the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick for a loved one, please contact the parish office.



INTERESTED IN BECOMING CATHOLIC OR RECEIVING MISSED SACRAMENTS?






