Dear Parish Family-

Many times when people think of a parish they think of an old institution in the center of a downtown area with a big gothic style Church that has been around 100-150 years. Our parish is only 57 years young, is in a semi-rural area (at least for NJ) and has a modern new Church.

So it may come as a surprise to many that there are still founding members of our parish who are still living here and actively involved in the parish. While the Parish was founded in 1964, the process of organizing and planning the parish began even before a piece of land was purchased to construct a building.

One of those founding members was Francis George Hubit, Jr.; better know to the founding and early families of the parish as Frank Hubit. Frank passed on to his eternal reward on Wednesday 12, 2022 and his funeral was directed by his good friend George Hassler on Tuesday January 18. He was 81. He would work with Msgr. Morello to raise up a new parish in Jackson starting in 1963, a year before the official founding. Due to Covid-19 issues our bulletins are printed well in advance and so this is the first opportunity to write something about Frank. His daughters both live out of State and his beloved wife Rose died on June 13, 2015 after an illness and was lovingly cared for by Frank.

Frank was the longest serving Trustee of St. Aloysius Parish, he became a Trustee in 1979 and served until the Diocese imposed term limits completing his service in 2019 along with his good friend and co-trustee George Hassler. Frank was very proud to be a Trustee of the Parish. Through the years, so the 'Old Timers' or 'lifers' tell me, he came to be known by the nickname, "Mr. Aloysius" for the many things he was involved in during his long membership in the parish.

In addition to being a trustee he also organized Bingo starting in 1967. He was on the Carnival Committee, an Usher, a money counter, buildings and grounds committee, New Church Building Committee, Faith in Our Future Cohort Team and, for most of his time in the Parish he served on the Finance Committee. On the finance committee he advised and counseled Msgr. Morello, Msgr. Casey, Fr. Scott, Fr. Kevin and myself – all the pastors from the parishes founding to the present; a pretty amazing record!

Frank was employed as an Engineer at Lockheed Martin where he worked on the NASA Space Mission; he was recognized for his dedication by having a moon rover named for him. Just before becoming ill he brought to the office a large collection of photos, memorabilia and commendations related to his work on America's Space program. It was an incredible experience to see these historic documents that told the story of America's golden age of Space exploration; you could hear, feel and see Frank's enthusiasm for the Space program, it was magical. Frank possessed an 'Engineer's Mind', he was thoughtful and exacting in his advice and counsel. His support and wise counsel was greatly appreciated by all the pastors of this parish but more importantly his sharing of his time, talent and treasure benefited every generation of parishioners. His dedication to St. Aloysius Parish cannot be measured but we pray God will reward him with the same generosity he blessed our parish with during his time among us! May he rest in Peace!

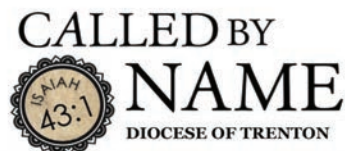

New ParishSOFT Giving Launch

To that end, we are making a few changes to how you can make your online donations. We are excited to announce that we have transitioned the new ParishSOFT Giving platform. This program allows for an easier experience for you, as well as for the parish office. The new giving platform can be accessed through our website at www.saintaloyisiusonline.org. Click on the GIVING tab in the blue bar at the top of the page and then on the red Donate Today button.

For all active recurring donors, we have transitioned your recurring gifts from our prior eGiving platform, My Own Giving, over to ParishSOFT Giving. When logging in for the first time, it is important to use the same email address as your original My Own Giving account and follow the set-up steps below. Your previous recurring gift in My Own Giving was cancelled automatically when we moved to ParishSOFT Giving and your recurring gift will now be processed in our new system at the same frequency and amount as before. Once you login to the new system you will be able to manage any recurring gifts that are active for you.

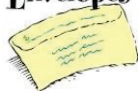

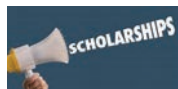
