Dear Parish Family,

This weekend, we celebrate the second Sunday of Easter within the Octave of Easter. The word 'octave' means eight. Some divine revelations are so great they must be celebrated for 8 days as if each day were THE day; the Resurrection is the first of these Octaves, Christmas also has an Octave. God created the world in 7 days and by the Resurrection of Jesus, the world was re-created on the eighth day. Jesus rose from the dead on a Sunday making it the eighth day. Sundays are always considered celebrations of the Resurrection, and, so are called, the eighth day for this reason; Easter being the first eighth day. All other Sundays of the Church Liturgical Year are little Easters for this reason. Sundays are never days of penance not even during Lent. Funerals cannot be celebrated on Sunday for the same reason.

This Sunday is also called "Divine Mercy Sunday", decreed by Pope St. John Paul II. The Divine Mercy image and Novena, along with accompanying devotions, come to us from the Polish nun, St. Maria Faustina Kowalska, born Helena Kowalska on August 25, 1905. The image of the Divine Mercy with the white and red rays coming from the heart of Jesus, hangs in the back of the Church surrounded by angels.

St. Faustina desired to serve the Church as a nun but, because she was uneducated, was turned away from many religious orders. For a time she was even homeless, living on the streets. At 18, she left her village by train to travel the 85 miles to Warsaw with only the dress she wore and, cleaned homes to earn some money. Finally, after some persuading, she entered the Convent of the Congregation of the Sisters of Our Lady of Mercy in Warsaw at the age of 20 on April 30, 1926 taking the name Sr. Maria Faustina of the Blessed Sacrament. She served in convents in Plock and Vilnius. She would begin to have visions of the Divine Mercy on Sunday, February 22, 1931 (the first of some 14 visions) while stationed in Plock. On October 5, 1938, at the age of 33, she died in Krakow, where her earthly remains are kept in the Basilica of Divine Mercy. For those who went on the Pilgrimage to Poland, we visited the shrine, the basilica and her relics. She kept an extensive diary of her visions and also reported them to her Spiritual Director, Fr. Michael Sopocko.

The most famous lines of the Novena are: "For the sake of his sorrowful passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world" and "Jesus, I trust in You!" The entire novena has been put to music as well. Traditionally, the Novena is prayed on Fridays at the 3pm hour, the hour of Jesus' Passion.

All of the modern Popes have commended the Church and the world to the Divine Mercy of Jesus, and said that we live in a time in need of God's unlimited mercy.

On this final day of the Octave of Easter, may the Divine Mercy of Jesus be with us and help us to "Trust in Him" alone!







In the Catholic Church, the anointing of the sick is a sacrament that is administered to a Catholic "who, having reached the age of reason, begins to be in danger due to sickness or old age". There is no need to wait until a person is at the point of death to receive the Sacrament. The Sacrament may be received at any time during a person's illness, especially before surgery or treatment. We suggest calling to receive the Sacrament *before* a person is in grave danger of death as it is not always possible to have a priest available at the actual time of

death. If you would like to schedule the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick for a loved one, please contact the parish office.


