Dear Parish Family,

This weekend marks the beginning of Holy Week, ushered in by Passion or Palm Sunday. The liturgy is a little different to mark the opening of Holy Week. We have a Gospel proclamation at the very beginning of Mass, recounting the triumphal entry of our Lord into the City of Jerusalem, where people create a carpet of palm for the Lord, and his burro, to enter the city. These same people will, in a few days time, shout "Crucify Him!" We are these same people, we shout Hosanna in the Highest to Jesus, but then by our sins, we recoil with "Crucify Him."



We call this week, the only week of the year given this title, "Holy Week". It is the most solemn of weeks marking the events of our salvation and the most important devotions of our liturgical year.

The Bishop will celebrate the Chrism Mass on Holy Monday, at the Co-Cathedral of St. Robert in Freehold, where all the Holy Oils for the coming year will be blessed. All are welcome to attend this Mass, if you have not taken part in a Chrism Mass, maybe consider attending this year. The Mass starts at 7pm.

There will be extra times for confessions in our parish during Holy Week. We will offer confessions on Holy Wednesday, beginning at 6pm, and Good Friday, beginning at 1pm. Many parishes offer either Tenebrae or the Seven Last Words, our parish will hold a service on Holy Wednesday at 7pm of the Seven Last Words of Jesus, taken from the writings of St. Josemaria Escriva.

Holy Thursday, the Mass of the Lord's Supper, will take place at 6pm, celebrated by our Bishop, David M. O'Connell, C.M., at which Graham Mulholland, who completing studies leading to Ordination to the Deaconate, will be installed in the Office of Acolyte.


Good Friday we will have confessions beginning at 1pm, and at 3pm, the Solemn Liturgy of the Passion with Veneration of the Cross, and Holy Communion. The Knights of Columbus will host a Fish Fry at their Council Home on Bartley Road following the Good Friday Liturgy.

On Holy Saturday, there will be the blessing of the Easter Foods at 11am, and the Solemn and Sacred Mass of the Vigil of Easter at 8pm, the Church's most solemn liturgy of the entire liturgical year.

Easter Sunday Masses are 7am, 8:30am and 10:30am.

I wish you a blessed and spiritually enriching Holy Week.

In the Catholic Church, the anointing of the sick is a sacrament that is administered to a Catholic "who, having reached the age of reason, begins to be in danger due to sickness or old age". There is no need to wait until a person is at the point of death to receive the Sacrament. The Sacrament may be received at any time during a person's illness, especially before surgery or treatment. We suggest calling to receive the Sacrament *before* a person is in grave danger of death as it is not always possible to have a priest available at the actual time of death. If you would like to schedule the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick for a loved one, please contact the parish office.








ICON PAINTING WORKSHOP JUNE 9-14, 2025
