Dear Parish Family-


It has been two weeks since the hand painted image of the Lord's Supper on Egyptian papyrus was hung in the Church. The painting was donated by those who went on the 2024 Egypt Pilgrimage. The frame is made of Plexiglas and does have a glare at certain times of the day, especially from the center back of the Church. If you move forward, the image becomes visible. One of our parishioners kindly had the frame fabricated for us and, it too was donated, a very generous donation, as it cost twice what the painting cost; a hearty thank you to this parishioner and his co-workers for an excellent job! So the beauty of the Church was enhanced at no cost to the parish for the spiritual inspiration of all.

During Holy Week, there was a power surge and our entire lighting system burned out. Thus, the Holy Thursday Mass was in darkness. The electricians came very early on Good Friday and dismantled the system and rewired it directly to the electrical panel. We once again have lights; however, we only have two settings-on and off! We are currently working on a solution.

Sometimes managing buildings and grounds is like playing "whack-a-mole". You fix one thing...like the leaking roof...and another problem arises...like a burned our lighting system. Well, in even tragic events, there is a silver lining. There were three sets of lights that did not work on the lighting system, two chandeliers and one set of floor lights. With everything wired directly to the panel, all the lights now work, so a small consolation! In other news, we received a grant to convert our parking lot lights from metal halide to LED, work should begin shortly. Our Holy Father wrote an entire teaching on ecology called "Laudato Si", and has been urging the Church to become more ecologically sensitive. With this conversion, the parish moves one step closer to a more sustainable model. We have already converted most of the Church lighting to LED, Gonzaga Hall is now LED, and we are working on converting the rest of the building to LED. The Alpha School already converted the space they use to LED.

Each of these projects is expensive, so I ask you to please consider this when contributing to the Parish each week. We strive to be good stewards of our resources, and have a very good Finance Council and Business Manager, as well as a conscientious staff.

In the Catholic Church, the anointing of the sick is a sacrament that is administered to a Catholic "who, having reached the age of reason, begins to be in danger due to sickness or old age". There is no need to wait until a person is at the point of death to receive the Sacrament. The Sacrament may be received at any time during a person's illness, especially before surgery or treatment. We suggest calling to receive the Sacrament *before* a person is in grave danger of death as it is not always possible to have a priest available at the actual time of

death. If you would like to schedule the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick for a loved one, please contact the parish office.






