Dear Parish Family-

Several months ago I gave you some data on our parish that was provided by the Diocese from reports distributed to each parish.

Last week the Chancellor of the Diocese of Trenton, Mrs. Terry Ginther, sent all pastors a “Summary of Findings” for Data collected Diocesan wide from 2022, the last year available.

This will be a two part bulletin letter; this week I will cover general statistics about our parishes and next week I will provide the second half of the Summary findings on Diocesan wide Sacramental Data.

- Number of Parishes in the Diocese of Trenton (Mercer, Monmouth, Ocean, Burlington Counties) – 97
- Number of Catholics living in the Diocese of Trenton – 640,000
- Percentage of Population in the Diocese who are Catholic – 30% of the population is Catholic
- Percentage of the Population of Ocean County that is Catholic – 24.5%
- Number of Catholics living in Ocean County – 156,363
- Number of Catholics Registered at one of the 97 parishes in the Diocese – 270,393
- Average Number of Catholics Registered at a parish - 2,788 (our Parish actual # registered families 6,004)
- Number of Parishes in the Diocese with more than 5000 registered households – 10
- Average Regular Weekend Mass attendance across the Diocese - 82,846, an increase of 5,466 over 2021
- Post Pandemic Mass attendance recovery – 69%
- Percent of Catholics who attend Mass weekly - 13%
- Number of Weekend Masses in the Diocese four counties - 458 (57 fewer than 2020 but 2 more than 2021)
- Church Capacity Utilization (size of the Church relative to the number of those attending Masses) – 28%  
*this statistic means that 4 of every 5 seats are empty.*
- Church seating capacity across the Diocese 150-1,300
- Church seating Capacity at St. Aloysius - 1,145
- Number of Weekend Masses at St. Aloysius - 5
- Church Capacity Utilization at St. Aloysius – 25% average but as low as 13% and as high as 33% at individual Masses.
- Trackable giving of registered families across the Diocese - 86,225
- Percentage of Registered families who give Diocesan Wide– 32%
- Percentage average of individual parish trackable registered family giving – 35%, some parishes as low as 20%

During the month of May we will be praying the Rosary every weekday morning beginning at 8:00am just prior to the 8:30am Daily Mass.

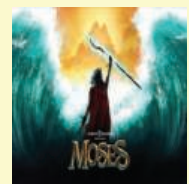
Please try to arrive a little early each day and join us in this special devotion to our Blessed Mother. We will resume with the Divine Mercy Chaplet in June.

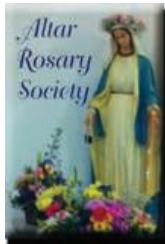

- We regret that once the Mass book is filled, we cannot accommodate any additional requests. Any request we cannot honor will be returned along with the stipend. However, the Annual Enrollment and Masses said at St. Mary’s Seminary will always be available.

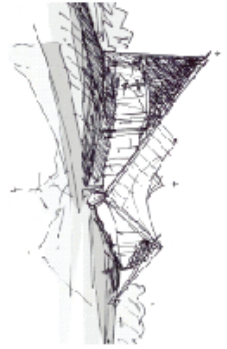
