Dear Parish Family-

We received notice this week that the State of New Jersey has raised the occupancy limits to 50% for Churches with a maximum limit of 200 people, six feet of distancing is required. With the 6-feet of distance, our occupancy remains the same. The State could increase it to 100% but with 6 feet of distance included it does not work. So for now we remain at 25% of occupancy. This is fine since we have not reached 25% at a single Mass time. We were also informed these may change in the near future. Masks are no longer required OUTSIDE but are still required inside.

While Covid-19 numbers have been steadily falling nationwide they continue to be high in our area of Ocean County. Our music director, who has 3 children, practically is a hermit but has none-the-less contracted the virus along with her husband and their toddler daughter, please pray for them. As you all know when a toddler gets sick it is nerve racking. Her illness was not contracted at the Parish and she informed us immediately thus we did not have music at the School Mass, last weekend or this weekend. We have been using substitutes for weddings and funerals.

Please pray for the Santora family and the repose of the soul of their daughter Stephanie. Stephanie was killed last weekend in a tragic accident when a tractor trailer slammed into the back of her car with such force the car burst into flames killing her and badly burning her passenger. Stephanie was a brilliant young woman just beginning her life. We extend condolences to her family at a very difficult and sad time. We have between 120-140 funerals a year, while all of them are sad occasions this one is particularly heart wrenching.

We also extend condolences to Jackson Township Councilman Andrew Kern whose father, Edward, died lovingly surrounded by his family and wife of nearly 60 years, may he Rest In Peace.

I attended a webinar this week on bias crime and sadly the event began with an announcement by the Attorney General that he had just filed a lawsuit against Jackson Township for Bias and animosity against the Orthodox Jewish Community of Jackson. Sadly and embarrassingly some laws passed in the Township over the last few years target our Orthodox neighbors. As one of the Police Chaplains noted in the Asbury Park Press, the majority of Jackson residents live in peace and harmony with their neighbors but a handful unduly sway our elected officials to pass discriminatory laws. These laws, clearly against American Democratic principles, should concern every citizen but most especially Religious Citizens since they show a clear bias against Religious Liberty. Sadly America, as it becomes more secular and socialist politically, also is becoming hostile to the free exercise of religion guaranteed in the US Constitution and Religious people increasingly must fight in the courts to exercise religion freely and without government interference. Please let our elected officials know we, religious Americans, are not demanding special rights but the rights already ours in the US Constitution. Do not be fooled by politicians who promise you these things would "not happen to Churches"; Hitler made similar overtures until he had absolute power and then even Christians were persecuted. Dachau Concentration Camp was the primary camp for Catholic Priests and Religious who refused to worship the altar of the Third Reich.

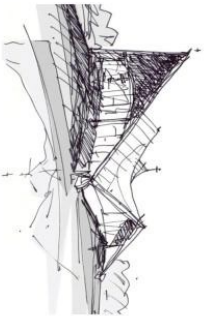

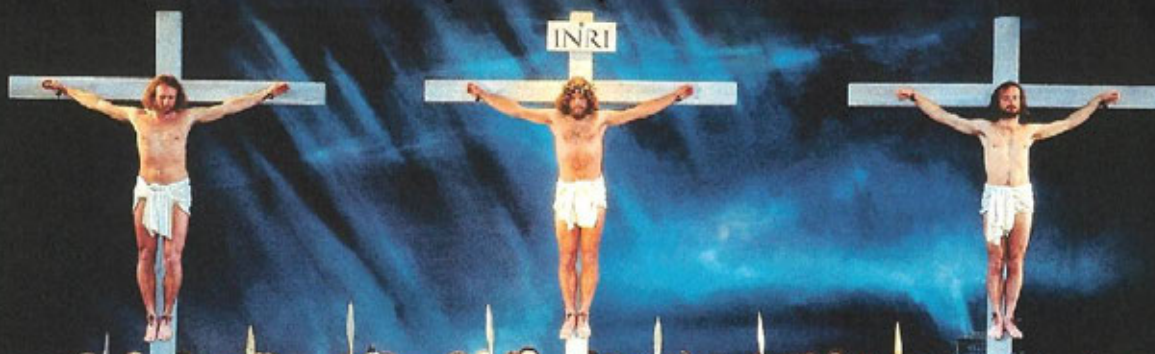
