Dear Parish Family-

At Pentecost Pope Francis said, “Listen to others. Read situations, we are road signs for others, we too, showing God’s way. Conversion is always done in dialogue, in dialogue with God, in dialogue with others, in dialogue with the world.”

In April the Holy Father announced his intention to convene the 16th Synod of Bishops. The theme of Synod is “For a Synodal Church; Communion, Participation and Mission. Last week he announced it will be a three year process in three parts: a diocesan phase, a Continental phase and a Universal phase. Our Diocese will open the Diocesan phase with a Mass on Sunday Oct. 19 at 3pm; the place has not yet been announced. Usually, but not always, Synod’s primarily entail just Bishops. For the 16th Synod the Holy Father invites all Catholics to participate through the Diocesan Phase. The Holy Father emphasized that listening is the key part of the process, “One listening to the others; and all listening to the Holy Spirit.” How the Diocesan Phase will be fleshed out has not yet been developed. Most likely there will at least be some form of a survey for individuals to fill out and possible meetings or other instruments used to allow full participation by all Catholics who desire to be part of the Synodal process. This is a very exciting opportunity for everyone to listen and be heard so I hope everyone will participate!

The New Jersey Bishop’s have made the decision to impose the Obligation to attend Mass in accord with the Code of Canon Law and the Catechism of the Catholic Church beginning the weekend of June 5/6. This means all Catholics are obligated to attend Mass every Sunday beginning on that weekend. Failure to attend Mass is a Serious/Mortal Sin that jeopardizes the soul’s eternal redemption and missing Mass means you must confess that Sin or refrain from receiving Holy Communion until you do go to Confession. The Bishops does note, *“This obligation does not apply to those who are ill; those who have reason to believe that they were recently exposed to the corona virus or another serious or contagious illness; those who are confined to their home, a hospital, or nursing facility; or those with serious underlying health conditions. One should consult the local pastor if questions arise about the obligation to attend Mass (canon 87).”*

Beginning Friday May 28 Governor Murphy announced Churches may operate at 100% of capacity and those who have been fully vaccinated can be without social distancing or masks. While we are still in the transitional phase of the returning to normal, please note the virus is still prevalent and strong among our populations so if you wish to continue to wear a mask that is fine. All distancing markers have been removed from the building. We will be making changes gradually over the course of several weeks and should the virus counts begin to rise we may have to return to some practices but for now we will follow the CDC, WHO, NJ Dept. of Health, Ocean County Dept. of Health and NJ State recommendations.

There has been some confusion regarding the recent changes in NJ Law regarding Covid-19. The changes implemented on May 28 **DO NOT apply to schools**, healthcare centers, hospitals and several other categories. Schools must follow NJ Executive Order 170, which requires masks and distancing, among other restrictions, in all Schools. The majority of students have either not received a vaccine or currently not allowed to receive a vaccine. So all events at MSA, including graduation, still have capacity limits, distancing and mask requirements.

This Sunday is Trinity Sunday where we solemnly commemorate the unified oneness of the three distinct persons of the Godhead; Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Glory to the Father, and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit; as it was in the beginning, is now and ever shall be, world without end. Amen!

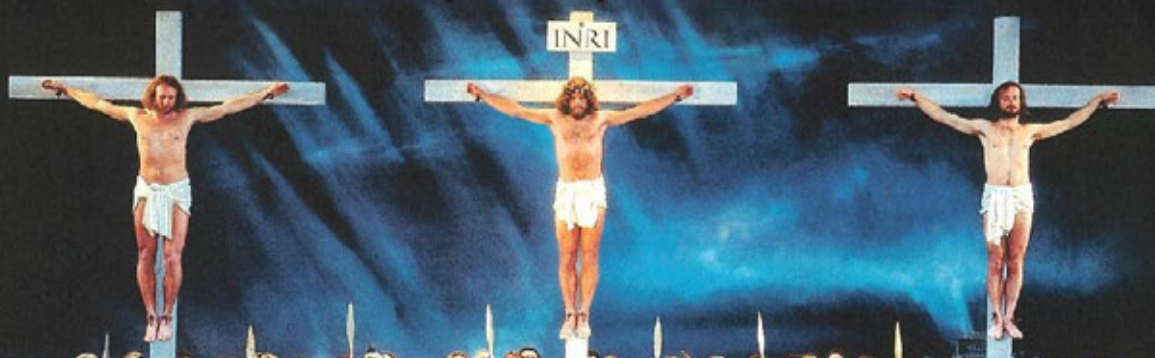
