Dear Parish Family,



We celebrate this weekend the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ, the central mystery of our faith. Before going to the Cross, Jesus instituted the Eucharist at the Last Supper in the Upper Room on Mount Zion in Jerusalem. He promised his apostles and disciples that he would remain with them until he comes again in glory at his second coming. Through the institution of the Most Holy Eucharist, he takes ordinary bread and wine, available in all cultures, and transubstantiates them into his Body and Blood. "He entrusted to his Church the memorial of his death and resurrection as a sign of unity, a bond of charity, a paschal banquet". (Catechism)

The Catechism further teaches us the Eucharist is "the source and summit of all Christian Life. In the Eucharist, the sanctifying action of God in our regard, and our worship of Him, reach their high point. It contains the whole spiritual good of the Church; Christ himself, our Pasch. Communion, with divine life, and the unity of the people of God, are both expressed and affected by the Eucharist. Through the Eucharistic celebration, we are united already with the liturgy of heaven and we have a foretaste of eternal life."

The Catechism teaches us, "The Eucharist is a memorial in the sense that it makes present, and actual, the sacrifice which Christ offered to the Father on the cross, once and for all on behalf of mankind. The Sacrificial character of the Holy Eucharist is manifested in the very words of the institution, "This is my Body which is given for you" and "This cup is the New Covenant in my Blood that will be shed for you" (Luke 22:19-20). The sacrifice of the cross and the sacrifice of the Eucharist are one and the same sacrifice. The priest and the victim are the same; only the manner of offering is different: in a bloody manner on the cross, in an unbloody manner in the Eucharist."

Further it states, "In the Eucharist, the sacrifice of Christ becomes also the sacrifice of the members of his body. The lives of the faithful, their praise, their suffering, their prayers, their work, are united to those of Christ."

In the Eucharist, the bread and wine presented by the people in the offertory, by the action of the Holy Spirit and the words of the Priest by means of transubstantiation, become the body, blood, soul and divinity of Christ, really, wholly, and substantially. As the Catechism reminds us, Christ is present in a sacramental way "under the Eucharistic species of bread and wine, Christ whole and entire, God and man." Therefore, in our worship at Mass, and before the tabernacle, which contains the Eucharistic species, "we offer worship "latría" that is, the adoration given to God alone. The Church guards, with the greatest care, hosts that have been consecrated."



After the conclusion of the 10:30am Mass, there will be a Eucharistic procession, all are invited to participate.

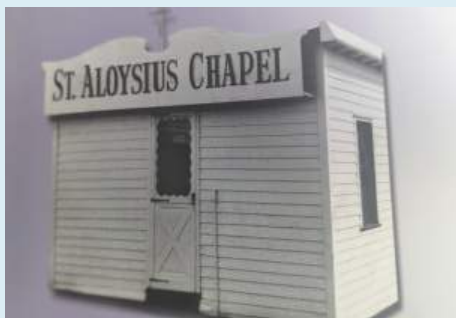



In the Catholic Church, the anointing of the sick is a sacrament that is administered to a Catholic "who, having reached the age of reason, begins to be in danger due to sickness or old age". There is no need to wait until a person is at the point of death to receive the Sacrament. The Sacrament may be received at any time during a person's illness, especially before surgery or treatment. We suggest calling to receive the Sacrament *before* a person is in grave danger of death as it is not always possible to have a priest available at the actual time of death. 

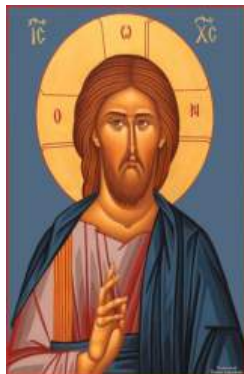
