Dear Parish Family,

Summer is here, and many of us are starting to travel and visit loved ones. Our parochial vicar, Fr. RJ Ballacillo, will be heading home to the Philippines to renew his visa and spend time with his family. The US Government recently reached a settlement with the Catholic Church over a rule issued by the Biden administration. This rule required those with a Religious Worker Visa to return to their home country for a year before renewing their five-year visa, a change from previous practice. Before this executive order, RI Religious Workers—such as priests, rabbis, ministers, imams, and pastoral workers—could simply go home, get their visa stamped at a US Embassy, and return.

Now, Fr. RJ can take his usual vacation home and renew his visa at the same time. He will need to stay for at least a month because of embassy processing times. He leaves on Sunday, June 21st at 1:30 am and, if all goes well, will return on Friday, July 24th. We wish him safe travels and a wonderful visit with his family and friends.

I want to thank Milan, one of our parishioners, for creating the banner in the church for the month of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, as well as the two banners on the front lawn celebrating America's 250th Anniversary. This June, we celebrate the love of the Sacred Heart of Jesus and look forward to the 250th anniversary of our country's founding and independence. I have fond memories of being in New York Harbor during America's bicentennial when I was 11 years old. Living on a boat for three days in front of Lady Liberty, watching tall ships and fireworks, was an experience I will never forget. I am grateful to be here for the 250th anniversary, though I know I won't see the 300th. Still, I cherish the sweet taste of freedom in the greatest country on Earth! Some people today might not agree with that, but honestly, if someone doesn't like it here, the door of freedom does swing both ways.

Enjoy your summer, and congratulations to all our graduates. I love seeing the graduation signs on your lawns and reading your stories in the news. Education is one of the greatest gifts of a republic like ours and important to success in the future.

Next Sunday is Father's Day. Two weeks ago I watched a new dad cradling his first born in his arms, rocking, patting, and walking the child around the room; both father and child were quite content. There is a way to receive the Sacrament of Matrimony before your destination wedding.

MARRIAGE CONVALIDATION - The Convalidation of a Marriage is a special wedding ceremony by which one's marriage is recognized and blessed by the Catholic Church. Through this process your marriage will be fully embraced by the Church, granting it all the spiritual blessings and benefits it offers. 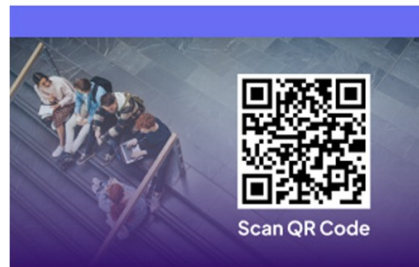
