Dear Fellow Parishioners,

This weekend, we celebrate the central mystery of the Christian Faith in the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, three divine persons sharing one divine nature. Non-Christians find this concept quite difficult to comprehend or grasp; indeed, so do many Christians! What we know of God's nature comes to us from Sacred Scripture. Jesus speaks of himself as the Son; he calls God His Father and refers to the Holy Spirit. It took Christians nearly three hundred years to define this mystery of our faith.

As Catholics, we constantly sign ourselves, as do Greek Orthodox and other Christian Orthodox Churches, with the sign of the Cross saying, "In the name of the FATHER and of the SON, and of the HOLY SPIRIT," calling to mind God's triune nature. So many of our prayers conclude by calling on the name of the Father, invoking the intercession of the Son, and including the Holy Spirit, then ending "ONE God forever and ever."

In St. John's Gospel, Jesus is called "The Word," which the Father spoke at the beginning of time to create the world and all in it; the Word of God became flesh in the womb of the Virgin Mary, Jesus Christ our Lord. The Holy Spirit is called the "Ruach" or Breath of God the Father in the Old Testament. Theologians describe this as a procession of the Word from the Father called "generation," and the procession of the Spirit from the Father and the Son called "Spiration." The three persons of the Trinity are subsistent relations, each fully divine and consubstantial with the other. The Most Holy Trinity's inner life is pure mutual inter-relational knowledge and love. Our destiny is to share in this union through the love of other people, and consummately, in the Trinitarian Life Itself. Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, as it was in the beginning is now and ever shall be! Amen!

Next weekend, we will celebrate the other central belief of our Catholic Faith, the real presence of Jesus, body, blood, soul and divinity, really, wholly and substantially, in the Most Holy Eucharist; the real presence of God who dwells among us and gives himself to us as food to sustain us on our journey to the House of the Father.

Next week's bulletin will carry a powerful message for those experiencing infertility. I have asked our Parish Catechetical Leader, Jen Petrillo, to be the guest letter with a most excellent piece she has put together based on Church teaching, and her family's experience with infertility.

In the Catholic Church, the anointing of the sick is a sacrament that is administered to a Catholic "who, having reached the age of reason, begins to be in danger due to sickness or old age". There is no need to wait until a person is at the point of death to receive the Sacrament. The Sacrament may be received at any time during a person's illness, especially before surgery or treatment. We suggest calling to receive the Sacrament *before* a person is in grave danger of death as it is not always possible to have a priest available at the actual time of death. If you would like to schedule the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick for a loved one, please contact the parish office.
