Dear Parish Family-



Summer is upon us! Leading up to the end of the school year, we have had May Crownings, First Communions, Weddings, Wedding Anniversaries, and Baptisms; now we add graduations! There are so many graduations now, Nursery School Graduation, Pre-School Graduations, Kindergarten Graduation, 5th grade Graduation, 8th grade Graduation, High School Graduation, 2-year College Graduation, 4year College Graduation, Grad School Graduation, Doctorate Graduation, Trade School Graduation, and a few 1 have probably missed! That is a lot of parties to attend!

We mark our passage in this world by these milestones, which we celebrate, and the older one gets, the faster the time passes! Last weekend, we had a wonderful celebration at the 5pm Mass for a couple married 65 years, a true witnesses to love! On Sunday, I attended a rare Anniversary, a 50th Anniversary of Ordination to the Priesthood for one of my former Seminary Professors, and mentor. The Pastor of the parish where he lives mentioned this in his remarks, how rare it is today to have a 50th Anniversary of Priesthood Celebration. The priest's sister said to me, "Can you believe we all made it to his 50th!" It was a perfect summer day, and so good to see people who taught me, people I taught, old classmates, former professors, and others.

Summer opens the door to so many get-togethers. When I was young, my family had many opportunities to get together and relax, that is less frequent today because of the pace and over commitment of our society. So it is nice when we can pause and celebrate and catch up.

There has been a slow decline, sped up by Covid lockdown, of religious practice, and with it, a decline in vocations to the priesthood and religious life. Recent studies show, however, a strong commitment among today's youth who practice the faith, their enthusiasm, and zeal for the Lord. I thought of this lass Sunday when I glanced across a packed Church for my professor's anniversary, there were so many young people! There were also a lot of Religious Sisters, an entire convent of young Dominican Nuns in flowing white habits! St. John Paul II said, "The Church is young", and indeed it is, both in terms of age and vitality.

This summer we will be undergoing renovations to the parish offices. The Alpha School has flourished here in its new location, nearly doubling in size, and they are bursting at the seams. We had a series of meetings with the parent company, RKS Associates, to expand their school into the "B Wing", which currently houses our Religious Education Office, Youth Room, storage, and meeting rooms. The "A Wing" houses the parish office, pastor's office and parochial vicar's office. Gonzaga Hall will be divided into various enclosed spaces. There are currently two existing enclosed rooms; one will be the youth room, and the other, a general meeting room. The open space will be divided into 4 conference rooms for meetings and Religious Education classes; these will all be divided using portable accordion dividers. The remaining space will be converted to a chapel. Please be patient and understanding with delays/disruptions/etc. Thanks!

Renovations began two weeks ago on four classrooms in the "B Wing" as the Alpha School will need the space beginning July 15th. Sometime after that, renovations will begin on the "A Wing", and may cause some temporary disruptions to parish office use.

In the Catholic Church, the anointing of the sick is a sacrament that is administered to a Catholic "who, having reached the age of reason, begins to be in danger due to sickness or old age". There is no need to wait until a person is at the point of death to receive the Sacrament. The Sacrament may be received at any time during a person's illness, especially before surgery or treatment. We suggest calling to receive the Sacrament *before* a person is in grave danger of death as it is not always possible to have a priest available at the actual time of

death. If you would like to schedule the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick for a loved one, please contact the parish office.
