Happy Father's Day to all the Fathers!


Father's Day has been a 'slow burn' holiday in America. While Mother's Day started right after the Civil War and gained traction fast, Father's Day was a bit slower in gaining traction. It started in Protestant Churches in 1909 in the State of Washington by the daughter of a Veteran (who was a single parent). She saw how popular Mother's Day became with the public and wanted the same for fathers. In 1916 President Woodrow Wilson tried to make it a national observance by urging Americans to celebrate Father's Day. By 1924 President Calvin Coolidge tried to move it along by urging State Governments to make it a state holiday. It was sporadically and occasionally observed but did not gain wide spread observance until becoming an official Federal holiday by President Richard Nixon in 1972 when it was assigned to the 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday of June. While not observed with the same enthusiasm as Mother's Day it has become part of the National Conscious and a day to honor our fathers, grandfathers and great-grandfathers.

This Sunday is observed in the Catholic Church as The Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ, once called Corpus Christi. The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops have initiated what they are calling a "Eucharistic Revival". Traditional Mass Catechesis by Fr. Jim  
Corpus Christi



This Sunday we have the blessed opportunity to participate in a Eucharistic Procession for the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi) following the 12PM Mass. Corpus Christi celebrates the institution of the Eucharist, the Sacrament of Holy Communion, at the Last Supper. Jesus says, "my flesh is true food, and my blood is true drink. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him" (Jn. 6:55-56).

The Eucharistic procession dates back to the fourteenth century, when the Blessed Sacrament was processed through the town after Mass on Corpus Christi Day. The Council of Trent approved and recommended the procession on Corpus Christi as a public profession of the Catholic faith in the real presence of Christ in the Holy Sacrament.

The Eucharistic Procession at St. Aloysius Church will commence immediate after the 12PM traditional ***Novus Ordo*** Mass. We will process the Blessed Sacrament with hymns of praise around the Church parking lot and courtyard. The procession will conclude with Benediction and Reposition in Gonzaga Hall.

Come join us this Sunday at 12PM for a more traditional version of the ***Novus Ordo*** Mass followed by the Eucharistic Procession.
