Dear Parish Family,

As we celebrate this Holy Year of Hope, we also mark the 15th Anniversary of Bishop O'Connell's Episcopal Ordination and give thanks for his ministry in the Diocese of Trenton. In the spirit of the Jubilee Year and recognizing the Bishop's Vincentian background (he is a member of the religious community of priests and brothers called the Congregation of the Missions (CM) founded by St. Vincent de Paul to help the poor), parish staff and parishioners are



asked to commit to carrying out corporal works of Mercy (an act of charity and compassion that helps others) **between June 15 and August 15** for the Bishop's intentions. He will then be presented with a "Bouquet of Good Works" to honor his anniversary.

As a reminder, a "Spiritual Bouquet" is a collection of prayers or devotional acts that someone has offered for someone else. It can be given from an individual or group to an individual or group to express joy, sorrow, or best wishes, often in commemoration of a special occasion. The recipient is given a card or something similar indicating who the giver is and what the spiritual bouquet consists of. With this in mind, in the Church's gathering space and listed below, are suggestions of good works for you to choose from, or you can creatively think of your own acts that would fit into the different categories. You can fill out the form below for each act or wait and tally up the acts of Mercy and give a total of all you offer. These acts of Mercy certainly align with our call to be "Pilgrims of Hope." To be such a pilgrim, you must walk through life with others in mind, offering them hope through our prayers and acts of Mercy.

Please return your addition to the "Spiritual Bouquet" no later than Sunday, June 29th, in the box marked "Bouquet of Good Works for Bishop O'Connell". Let us all consider contributing to this special anniversary gift to Bishop O'Connell and living out our call to be Pilgrims of Hope.

In the Catholic Church, the anointing of the sick is a sacrament that is administered to a Catholic "who, having reached the age of reason, begins to be in danger due to sickness or old age". There is no need to wait until a person is at the point of death to receive the Sacrament. The Sacrament may be received at any time during a person's illness, especially before surgery or treatment. We suggest calling to receive the Sacrament *before* a person is in grave danger

of death as it is not always possible to have a priest available at the actual time of death. If you would like to schedule the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick for a loved one, please contact the parish office.







This annual event is a wonderful opportunity for teens in grades 8 through 12 to spend a day giving of their time in service to others, while meeting fellow teens from around our diocese. The Ocean County service day will take place at Seeds of Service at Church of the Visitation in Brick, NJ on Tuesday, July 8th from 9:00 am to 4:00 pm. Retreat Opportunity: For the third year in a row, Ms. Catherine Werner, the Director of Youth Ministry at St. Joseph in Toms River, has invited AYM to join teens from CYGNUS (their parish youth ministry) on their summer retreat for teens in grades 9 through 12! Retreats are a wonderful way to set aside some time to grow in our relationship with God and with fellow members of our Catholic community. Seven young people from our parish are preparing to make a pilgrimage to the National Catholic Youth Conference in Indianapolis in November of 2025. This is a powerful event where thousands of Catholic high school teens from around the country come together to experience the reality that they are not alone in living out their faith. The multi-day conference includes Masses, Eucharistic adoration, dynamic music, engaging talks, a variety of workshops and speakers on various faithrelated topics, and many opportunities for teens to connect with peers from other parishes. We will continue

our fundraising efforts over the next several months, and any amount is appreciated. However, please know that there are opportunities available for a full sponsorship of one of our teens.
