Dear Parish Family,

With Fr. RJ away till the end of July, and Fr. McDevitt off for the weekend, I was a one handed paper hanger last weekend. The upside (or down) was I celebrated all the Masses, which means you all heard the same homily! In the Gospel of Matthew, Jesus calls our attention to the lowly humble sparrow as a sign of God's love and providential care for us. After the Masses, I learned many of you are bird lovers or know someone who is.

I like birds, but I wouldn't call myself a true bird watcher. I enjoy seeing the birds at my feeders, but I don't have special outfits or chase after them with binoculars and guidebooks. Sometimes I visit the Cornell University website for bird advice. Cornell has a great Veterinary School and a whole department dedicated to the study of birds, called Ornithology. You can visit their site at [www.birds.cornell.edu](http://www.birds.cornell.edu).

Some people asked how I keep squirrels and chipmunks out of my feeders. I use nine-foot shepherd's hooks, placing them near a large shrub and a medium tree, but far enough away so squirrels can't jump onto the feeders. The birds can still skedaddle quickly if a raptor comes by. The height is too much for squirrels to jump, and I've taped a slinky to the pole, which they don't like because it moves. I also put a bird bath between the poles for water and bathing. The tall pole and slinky are the only things that keep the squirrels away. Of course, they still get plenty to eat, since the birds have not learned to eat with British manners, so plenty drop for the bigger birds, squirrels, and chipmunks.

Please join me in thanking God for 25 years of faithful service as a deacon as we celebrate the 25<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of Deacon Uku Mannikus' ordination to the permanent diaconate. Deacon Uku is of Estonian heritage and grew up in the Estonian Orthodox tradition, which is a branch of the Russian Orthodox Church. He was received into the Catholic Church around the time he married his wife, Christal. Deacon Uku has four sons (one of whom is deceased) and one daughter. He has several grandchildren, and the family is still growing, as his daughter who married last year, is expecting a baby in the new year ahead. He truly enjoys being a grandfather too!

After his ordination in 2001, Deacon Uku began his ministry at St. Veronica's in Howell, then moved to St. Aloysius in 2004. After many years of living in Jackson, the family moved to Millstone a few years ago. Deacon Uku has baptized countless babies, witnessed many marriages, led wake and graveside services, and counseled quite a few souls. We are most grateful for his ministry of Word, Sacrament, and Charity following the example of St. Stephen, the first deacon and martyr of the Church. Congratulations Deacon Uku on 25 years of dedicated service and many more to come!!!

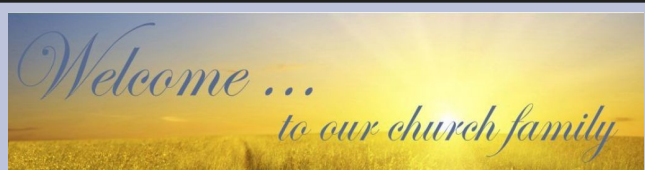

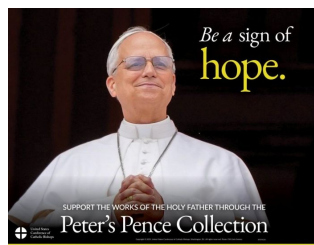

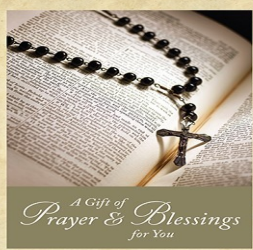

Amen

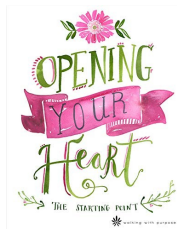


Weekly Bible study, led by Fr. RJ, is on summer break. The group will resume Tuesday, September 8th. Enjoy your summer! Read your Bible!

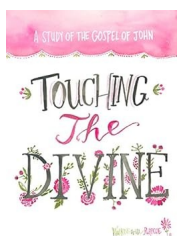

If you are making plans for a "destination wedding," please call the parish office first. There is a way to receive the Sacrament of Matrimony before your destination wedding.

**MARRIAGE CONVALIDATION** - The Convalidation of a Marriage is a special wedding ceremony by which one's marriage is recognized and blessed by the Catholic Church. Through this process your marriage will be fully embraced by the Church, granting it all the spiritual blessings and benefits it offers. If you are interested in learning more about a Marriage Convalidation contact the parish office.



To begin the process of scheduling a date for Baptism, families are asked to be registered in the parish. Parents and Godparents are required to attend a Baptism Prep Class, and Godparents will need to provide a Letter of Eligibility from their current parish (where they reside). Baptisms are held most Sundays at 12:00pm, following the 10:30am Mass. For more information or to schedule a date, please call the parish office.

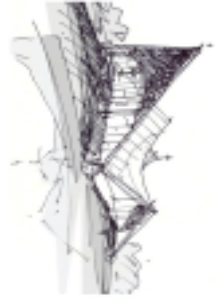
