Dear Parish Family,

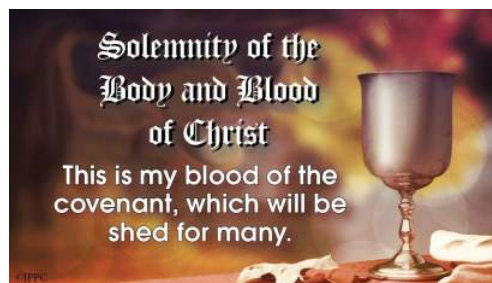
This Sunday is the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ, one of two Solemnities in Ordinary Time that follow immediately after the Season of Easter. The Eucharist, Christ's body and blood, is the most treasured and supreme of the Sacraments. The Lord gave us himself at the Last Supper before going to the Cross. He did this to keep his promise to remain with us until he comes again in glory and the world is consumed and subsumed to the Godhead. The Second Vatican Council called the Eucharist "the source and the summit" of Christian life.

It is easy to become lax in our belief when we celebrate it regularly, but it is always a miracle and sign of God's infinite love for us. That is why it is important we prepare ourselves properly and be properly disposed to receive Holy Communion. The Church requires that only Catholics of Catechetical age can receive communion, those who have a basic understanding. We should fast for one hour from food and beverages before reception of Holy Communion, and if we are aware of mortal sin, that it be confessed before reception of Holy Communion. We should dress appropriately, approach with reverence, participate fully, and give ourselves completely at Mass.

The past week was an eventful one. Some of you may recall that, in December, I wrote in this space that we were informed, in the first week of December of 2025, of an imminent "review of our Finances and financial procedures" in what was characterized as "a letter of engagement" (but no diamond ring was in the envelope). A lot of euphemisms to say we were to be audited! I must be getting old because I tire of all the euphemisms and renaming that goes on these days!

On Monday, June 1st, seven months after the 'letter of engagement,' the firm of Repice and Taylor, Inc of Philadelphia arrived with a team of four 'engagers', aka auditors (heck, I might as well create a few euphemisms myself!). They arrived at approximately 9:30 a.m. and concluded by 3:30 p.m. In our internet age, audits have become a little easier, as the firm emailed us a list of items to be sent electronically and a questionnaire to be returned by email. In anticipation of their arrival, boxed items were prepared for a 'paper' review, and the Principal of the Firm withdrew the rest using a thumb drive from our computer. This certainly speeded up the review process. I remember the days (yikes, I am old) when boxes upon boxes had to be prepared, and the audit took at least a week or over a month if it was forensic. Repice and Taylor, Inc. were pleasant, a pleasure to work with, and very efficient. They did not indicate any abnormalities or serious issues to us. We were told a full computer-generated report would be given to the Diocese in about one month, and it would then be up to the Diocese to pass it on to us, which might take considerably longer. So I anticipate we should have the report no later than the fall of this year. I will inform you of any findings when we have the report. The firm told me they were doing twenty parishes between December 2025 and June 2026.
