Dear Parish Family-

I want to thank the Knights of Columbus for providing the food and set up for Fr. Jim Smith's farewell on Sunday June 18 at 1pm. They did a great job of feeding some 200+ plus people and tidying up afterwards!

The Knights of Columbus will also be providing the parish with a Communion Breakfast to welcome Fr. RJ Ballacillo on Sunday, August 6th following the 10:30am Mass. This will be a "Welcome Communion Breakfast"; this weekend was chosen as it is nearest to August 4<sup>th</sup>, the Feast of St. John Vianney who is the patron of Priests. Please come out and join us to welcome and get to know our new Parochial Vicar.

The last weekend Fr. Jim was with here I had folks *thanking me* and *congratulating me!* Can you believe? I guess being pastor here for 10 years I am still considered the "new" guy; either that or Fr. Jim and I looked so much alike, afterall he is tall, thin, beard and mustache and bald plus more than 14 years younger, and I am short, portly, mop head of hair, clean shaven and 14 years older so I can see how we could be confused for one another! LOL This is not the first time I have been confused for someone who looks completely different than me, I had a parishioner in another parish think a Nigerian priest was me! Reality is stranger than fiction! Roof work on the New Church is expected to begin in July. The entire standing seam metal roof will be removed and replaced with a PVC roof that will flex and move with the building. The new will be the same grey color you see now and will have PVC ribs glued on to imitate the standing seam metal roof. Visually it will largely remain the same only without leaks inside the building.

During re-roofing, currently estimated to take 4-5 months, all weekday Masses and Funerals will take place in Gonzaga Hall, similar to when the floor had to be jack hammered to replace the leak in the HVAC system some years back. At this juncture it appears we may only be in Gonzaga during the week but, I must warn you, that could change. We may have to have all Masses in Gonzaga depending on how things progress. Notice may be short so please be patient and understanding. This is a short term project for a long term reward.

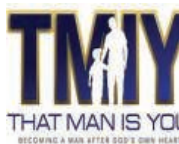




Beginning July 2, the 12:00pm Solemn Mass will no longer be on the schedule. If you are looking for a Traditional Mass, please contact the parish office for locations.

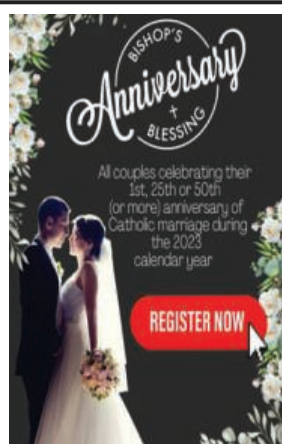

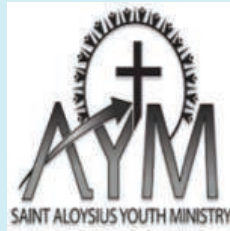
