Dear Parish Family,

I am pleased to announce Bishop David M. O'Connell has transferred Permanent Deacon Vincent Rinaldi to serve at St. Aloysius effective August 1. Deacon Vincent Rinaldi is a Permanent Deacon of the Diocese of Trenton ordained in 2005. His first assignment as a Permanent Deacon was at St. Catherine of Siena in Farmingdale from 2005-2012. He was transferred to serve as Pastoral Assistant at St. Mary in Colts Neck from 2012-2018. In 2018 he was transferred to St. Robert Co-Cathedral in Freehold.

A year ago he and his wife Cathy downsized, like many of you, moving to an active lifestyle 55+ community in Jackson to be nearer to their children Dominique and Victoria and grandchildren who live in Jackson.

Deacon Vincent Rinaldi goes by the nickname 'Vin', he works full time in the printing industry. The Rinaldi's joined the parish a year ago and have mostly been attending the 8:30am Mass on Sunday. With the official transfer of Diaconal Ministry to St. Aloysius he will begin service here as a Deacon in August. We welcome Deacon Vin to our clergy appointments joining myself, Fr. Jim, Msgr. Joe, Fr. Jim, Deacon Uku and Deacon Rene.


