Dear Parish Family,

Last Monday, we welcomed Msgr. Matthias Kamyerezi, retired Vicar General of the Kasana-Luweero Diocese in Uganda, is visiting our parish for his vacation. While retired for some years, he currently works as the Senior Secretary to the Chancery and the Diocesan Censor of Books. Some kind people, friends of his nephew, Fr. Peter, paid for his plane fare. Fr. Peter studied for the priesthood in Chicago and works in the Kasana-Luweero Diocesan Center. Msgr. joked with me that as Vicar General, he was Fr. Peter's boss, and now his nephew is his boss! Msgr. Matthias will be with us until September 1, when he will return home.

I would like to take this opportunity to congratulate Carolina Rivera-Colon, a member of our AYM (Aloysius Youth Ministry) group, who has achieved the "Summit" award, the highest achievement in the Scouting America Venturing Program. She is one of only four youths in the Northern Lights District to have achieved this award, and the other three youths were present to cheer her on. Carolina's Summit project was to design "Barnegat Bay Buddies" for Save Barnegat Bay, a non-profit environmental organization. She developed and executed more than a dozen icons of the native wildlife indigenous to Barnegat Bay. These will be used as markers and accompanying explanations to educate people using the trails, waterways, rivers, streams, boats, and other places that are part of the Barnegat Bay watershed ecosystem. I was very proud of her for this concentration on the environment. It is a central part of Pope Francis' emphasis on caring for our common home, the earth, and is central to his Encyclical, "Laudato Si".

Congratulations are in order for Jim and Jeannette Bruno, who celebrated their 40th Anniversary of marriage last week at the 10:30am Mass. Jeannette is our Scheduling Coordinator for ministries and serves as an Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion both on weekends and to the homebound. Congratulations and many more happy years together!

Wednesday, the Diocese held the Jubilee for Parish Personnel celebration entitled "Living and Serving as Pilgrims of Hope" in conjunction with the Holy Year of Hope at the Diocese Co-Cathedral of St. Robert Bellarmine in Freehold. Our offices were closed at noon so our parish staff could attend the afternoon set aside for them. It was also the celebration of the 15th Anniversary of Bishop David M. O'Connell, C.M., as Bishop of Trenton. The Chancellor of the Diocese of Trenton, Mrs. Terry Ginther, presented the Bishop with the Spiritual Bouquet collected from every parish in the Diocese of the works of Mercy performed across the Diocese in his honor—a big thank you to all who contributed to the Works of Mercy Spiritual Bouquet from our parish.

Last week, a parishioner remarked about the decline in the number of families and the weekly collection. My first observation is that it is summer, and families tend to go away during the summer. However, this is mainly due to the changing demographics of our town, as everywhere you see 'for sale' signs, including the Edge, which has closed and been sold. The School Board closed one elementary school, one middle school, and one high school at the end of the last school year due to several factors, the most significant being changing demographics and a steep decline in the birth rate. While our parish census is still relatively high, hovering at 6,000 families, only about 1,200 people attend Mass on any given weekend; this is our new reality. Pope Benedict XVI once observed that the Church will be smaller but stronger in the future.
