Dear Parish Family,

Thank you to all who contribute to the Missionary Cooperative Plan (MCP) this weekend, assisting the Church Missions in Guatemala, our southern neighbor in Central America. Your generous donations will have an immediate impact on the lives of very poor people.



Last Monday, on the feast of St. Clare of Assisi, a Franciscan saint, we were blessed with the wonderful presence and visit of Brother Ruffino Poster, who made his final profession in the Franciscan Friars of the Renewal seven years ago. Many parishioners attended the event in NYC. Brother Ruffino has been stationed in Honduras at an orphanage and was recently transferred to the Priory in the Bronx to take on the role of the Order's Vocation Director, responsible for encouraging vocations to the Franciscans and overseeing their formation within the Order. He is visiting with his parents, Carol and Jerry Poster, who now live in Florida but used to live in South Knolls. During our visit, I learned something new: the first Brother Ruffino was one of St. Francis' earliest followers (which I already knew), and he was also a cousin of St. Clare of Assisi (which I did not know).

On Tuesday, John and Marie Genaurd visited. They, too, moved to Florida some years ago, but were visiting their son, Doug, in Old Bridge and stopped by to say hello. John painted the portraits of Padre Pio, St. Theresa of Calcutta, St. Francis of Assisi, St. Theresa of the Little Flower, St. John Paul II, and St John XXIII. Summer brings welcome visitors and the renewal of friendships forged in faith!

I am often asked the question on Sunday, "Where is Chloe?". For those who don't know, Chloe is my dog; she is a certified Therapy Dog through Bright and Beautiful Therapy Dogs. She comes to Church to greet people with me when I do not have the Mass. If I have Mass, she stays at the parish house. She accepts scratches and belly rubs, and then you're her best friend! She usually wears her uniform, a red vest with her name, the certifying agency's name, and the training center's name all clearly visible, and is on a red lead with the identifying agency's name. Sometimes I forget to put her uniform on her. She also has a Canine Good Citizenship Certification through the American Kennel Club (AKC). She is a rescue dog from Rescue Ridge, a non-profit animal welfare organization affiliated with Animal Aid USA, whose president and founder is Prince Lorenzo Borghese. If his last name seems familiar, it is because Pope Francis was a frequent visitor to the Borghese Chapel and is buried next to the Borghese Chapel in the Papal Basilica of St. Mary Major in Rome. The Prince's family Crypt is directly below the Borghese Chapel. They are a very old, noble Italian family.

The summer has flown by quickly. Enjoy these last dog days of summer!
