Dear friends at St. Aloysius,

Mary's Meals is a very simple mission that works. We are an international school feeding program that supplies healthy meals to children in some of the world's poorest communities, **always in the students' places of education.** Mary's Meals provides an immediate benefit of nourishment to hungry children – sometimes the only full meal a child will have in the day – and the long-term benefit of making it possible for children who are otherwise out of school working or begging to attend school and gain a basic education that can help them escape poverty and transform their communities.

Mary's Meals is named in honor of the Blessed Virgin Mary. We remember that she knew what it was to raise a child in poverty, and we seek to honor her in the work we do and the way that we carry out our mission.

There are so many wonderful charitable missions in the world, but there are a few things that make Mary's Meals' mission unique:

Mary's Meals relies on local volunteers to carry out the cooking and serving of meals, allowing for local ownership and pride in carrying out the mission

Mary's Meals is a very low-cost, no-frills, low-overhead charity, and it costs us only **\$21 to feed a child every school day for an entire year. 93% of all donations go directly toward charitable activity.**

As much as possible, Mary's Meals relies on local food sources from small farmers to provide food for school meals. This keeps costs low, and also provides a benefit to the local economy in poor areas

Mary's Meals began in 2002 after our founder, Magnus MacFarlane-Barrow, was in Malawi on a mission trip. Appropriately enough, the inspiration for Mary's Meals began with the words of a child. While in Malawi, Magnus visited the home of a boy named Edward and his family in a poor village, and while there asked Edward what his dreams were. Edward replied that he hoped one day **"to attend school and have enough to eat."** Edward's words made clear how much these two items – **having enough to eat and the ability to attend school** – were tied together, and this comment helped inspire the beginning of Mary's Meals as a school feeding program. Mary's Meals started serving 200 children in Malawi in 2002, and now serves over 2.1 million children in 20 countries. **Mary's Meals is supported primarily from grassroots donations from individuals and parishes across the world.**

Car payments/repairs - \$2,095.30, Phone/internet -\$1,557.54, Appliances/furniture - \$1,341.82  
Childcare -\$1,174.06, Miscellaneous - \$1,580.19.*

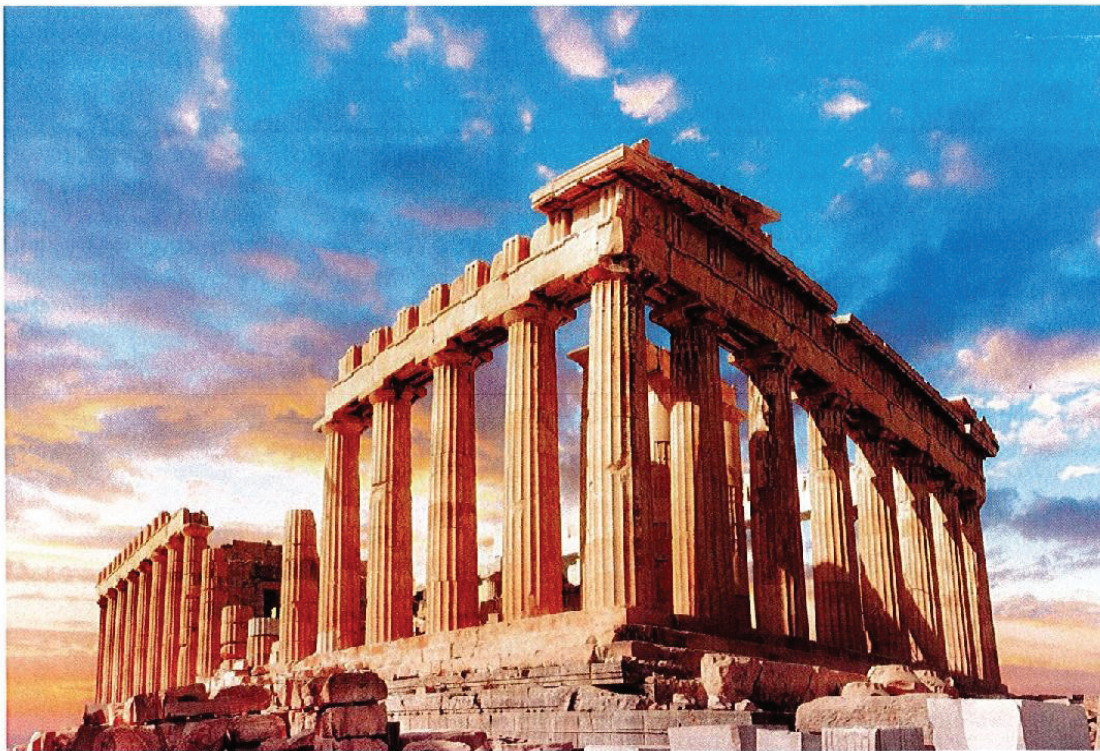

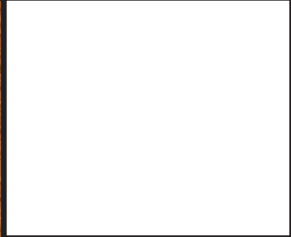

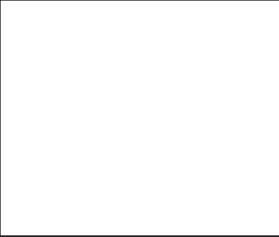
