Dear Parish Family,

Worship Aides (aka 'Hymnals') are currently posted weekly on our website for either download or viewing on an electronic device as a temporary solution to not having them in the pews due to Covid 19. These are ordered generally a year in advance. We cancelled our order due to the shut down and pandemic, avoiding the high expense of purchasing them not knowing when or if they could be used. They are generally ordered a year in advance and arrive on the First Sunday of Advent each year as the new Liturgical Year begins.

Several people have asked me about our plans for worship aides, aka hymnals. The pandemic has allowed us the time to evaluate how and what kind of Worship Aide we will be using going forward.

Our Holy Father Pope Francis, in his Encyclical *Laudato Si*, asks all of us to have concern for the environment. He continually preaches to the Church and humanity to look at the way we are using the earth's limited resources and reminding us to be good stewards of the earth. He invites us to move away from a throw away culture and to find ways to limit our carbon footprint. We have for decades used a disposable yearly missal which means at the end of the Liturgical Year we fill our dumpster and thus the landfill with nearly 1000 books. The annual disposal of throw away worship aides is a detriment to the environment and the pandemic has allowed us to pause and consider how we could be better stewards of creation. If we transitioned to using a dedicated book we are avoiding filling the dumpster and landfill each year. We can have a Worship aid that is both helpful and more environmentally sound.

I am happy to say after an exhaustive search and review of dozens of options and companies our Director of Sacred Music has recommended the St. Augustine Worship Book. This is a long lasting hardcover book with Mass parts, hymns, and readings. They are more bit expensive in the short term but economical in the long term. We believe this is a good solution to annual waste and still provides most of what we require each week in terms of liturgical aide. If all goes according to plan they should be in place for the First Sunday of Advent. Please DO NOT take these home, stealing is a sin! As in the past, if you wish to have a personal copy we would be happy to order you one at the appropriate cost, a notice will be in the bulletin prior to the change.

A gentle reminder we have begun collecting food again on the 3<sup>rd</sup> weekend of the month for local food pantries. Many thanks to all who contributed in the month of July; we had a good response after 18 months. See the bulletin for details of what may be requested, we will regularly collect on the 3<sup>rd</sup> weekend of the month. You can drop off non-perishables any time in the brown box in the Gathering Space of the Church.

### Our Holy Father Pope Francis Appeal for Americans to get vaccinated

We have been receiving a fair number of phone calls regarding the Catholic Church's stance on Vaccination. While Fr. Bambrick has written extensively about this issue and we have made announcements weekly for months encouraging people to get vaccinated, recent media reports have raised the question about exemptions for religious reasons. The Catholic Church encourages, promotes, supports and approves of Covid-19 vaccination. Pope Francis has called it a "moral obligation" ("*I believe that morally everyone must take the vaccine,*" the pontiff said in a Jan. 10 2021 interview for Italy's TG5 news program. "*It is the moral choice because it is about your life but also the lives of others.*") and in this video he calls it an "*act of love*" for the Common Good of Humanity. From the point of view of the Catholic faith there are no religious objections to the Covid-19 vaccines. At the same time the Church recognizes the right of individuals, for conscience or health reasons, may chose not to get vaccinated but the Church has no religious objections to the vaccine (quite the opposite). The Holy Father recently partnered with Ad Council of the USA to produce a video along with several Cardinals from the America's to promote vaccination among Christians of North, Central and South America. We urge you to listen to the Holy Father's Appeal, made in his native Spanish but with English Sub-Titles.

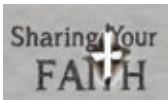

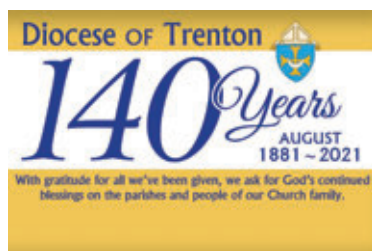

**Did you know that this August marks the 140<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Diocese of Trenton?** In 1881, Pope Leo XIII established the Diocese of Trenton to serve the Catholics of the southern part of New Jersey and named Father Michael J. O'Farrell of New York as its first bishop. At the time, the Diocese had 68 churches, 23 parochial schools and 51 priests spread out across Burlington, Mercer, Monmouth and Ocean Counties, as well as all of the territory that is now part of the Dioceses of Camden and Metuchen.
