Dear Parish Family-

A most generous thank you to all those who contributed to the Missionary Cooperative Plan (MCP) last weekend. The Missionary Cooperative Plan is an organized national plan that invites Missionaries from around the globe, including those in the USA, to enter the Dioceses during the months of July and August. It is through coordinated work of each Diocesan Mission Office that Missionary Societies are assigned. The Mission Office of the Diocese of Trenton vets the requests and assigns the Mission Society to two parishes to present their needs and share the work they do on behalf of the poor and the underdeveloped places on earth. This year our Parish was assigned Mary's Meals, named in honor of the Blessed Virgin Mary. A United Kingdom based charity founded by a Lay Catholic Missionary to feed school age children around the globe. They are a mostly volunteer charity.

We were blessed to have Gillian Giangrande, a Catholic Young Adult from the Basilica of St. John the Evangelist Parish in Stamford, Ct. Gillian encountered Mary's Meals while on a pilgrimage and was impressed with the encounter; since that time she has been a volunteer for Mary's Meals. She drove to St. Aloysius to make the 7am Mass on Sunday, now that is dedication, and you know she believes in the Mission of Mary's Meals to make that kind of sacrifice!

The total amount collected last weekend was \$7,371.00, which includes checks made payable directly to Mary's Meals, which we will forward to them. I emailed Gillian the amount on Monday and she responded that the total represents the feeding of 351 children for a year! Several parishioners also expressed that they will make their donation online. This is one of the most successful MCP collections in several years and the largest since the start of Covid-19!

Mary's Meals was originally assigned a date in July however, because they are an all volunteer organization, had difficulty finding a person to come make the presentation and asked if they could reschedule--thus Gillian came this weekend. In fact, they could not provide a volunteer for Saturday and I made the presentation on their behalf at the 5pm Mass. I noted how providential this all was since in the last paragraph of the Gospel this weekend, the Lord urges us to feed, literally hold a banquet, for the poor and the outcast. He warns us not to expect a reward for our charity, to feed those who cannot say thank you directly to us but assures us we will receive a reward at the Resurrection of the Righteous. The perfect Gospel for the MCP presentation, God is good in all His works!

Thank you to Gillian and to those who contributed to providing meals in the Holy Mother Mary's name to hungry children, whoever they are, wherever they are, around the globe. The Gospel was fulfilled in our hearing!

Happy Labor Day to all and best wishes and prayers for all those heading back to School!

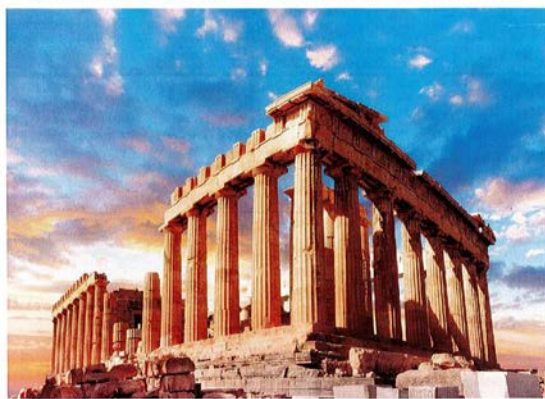

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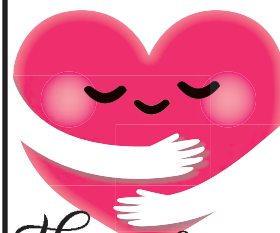
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
