Dear Parish Family,

Last weekend you probably noticed some changes in the parking lot. We are in the process of top coating, and restriping the parking lot. This has not been done in several years, and the lines were beginning to disappear. The top coat helps to preserve the blacktop, which dries out over time. The project was due to be completed the last week of August, while the Alpha School was on a short two week summer break; however, it rained for two days which put us behind schedule. Top coating is also quite expensive since it is made with crude oil, and prices are high!

The work on reconfiguring our office space is largely completed. All parish offices are now located in the A-wing of the building; administration, clergy, music and Religious Education. It is very cozy!

Gonzaga Hall will be divided into 4 multiuse rooms using portable dividers, which allow us to convert to an open space, if needed. The 4 multipurpose rooms will be used by the Religious Education program as classrooms, and the rest of the time they will be available for group meetings. The rooms are quite large with walls made of acoustical material to lessen sound. While portable rooms with doors, they can be folded away. The remaining space will be configured into a small chapel.

On Thursday, September 19th at 6pm, I will give a presentation on Women's Leadership in the New Testament and Early Church in anticipation of our new women's bible study, Walking with Purpose.

The Catholic Liturgical Calendar celebrates only 3 Nativities (birthdays); the Nativity of the Lord on Dec. 25th, The Nativity of St. John the Baptist on June 24<sup>th</sup>, and, the Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary on Sept. 8th. This Sunday is Sept. 8th; however, the Resurrection of the Lord always takes precedence over minor feasts. Therefore, the liturgical prayers are for the 23<sup>rd</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time. Never-the-less, this day is still the day when we recall the Blessed Virgin Mary's Nativity or Birth. The feast has its origin in the City of Jerusalem, where it was first celebrated in the Basilica of the Nativity of Mary; today the Basilica is called St. Anne, located just inside St. Stephen's Gate (sometimes called the Lions' Gate). The Basilica of St. Anne is built over the home of SS. Joachim, Anne and Mary. If you visit Jerusalem, you can go under the Basilica into the home of this holy family, and celebrate Mass at one of the altars set up in the various rooms. The Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary is exactly 9 months after the Immaculate Conception of Mary in her mother's (St. Anne) womb on Dec. 8th. Happy Birthday Virgin Mary, our Mother!

With Labor Day behind us, the hum and buzz of life begins again in earnest, where did the summer go?




### Prayer to St Michael The Archangel

In the Catholic Church, the anointing of the sick is a sacrament that is administered to a Catholic "who, having reached the age of reason, begins to be in danger due to sickness or old age". There is no need to wait until a person is at the point of death to receive the Sacrament. The Sacrament may be received at any time during a person's illness, especially before surgery or treatment. We suggest calling to receive the Sacrament *before* a person is in grave danger of death as it is not always possible to have a priest available at the actual time of death. If you would like to schedule the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick for a loved one, please contact the parish office.
