Dear Parish Family-

It is back to school time! The St. Vincent de Paul Society had a very successful back to school drive thanks to your help. We gave away supplies which included backpacks, paper, pencils, pens, highlighters, calculators, notebooks, binders, folders, staplers, rulers, scissors, crayons, markers, paperclips, etc. to 74 children from 37 families. All of them were very grateful for the supplies. There were some remaining supplies which were given to Catholic Charities since they were short this year. A BIG thank you to the members of the SVdP Society who manned the 'store' that week and assisted the children and welcomed the families.

I have no news on the Church roof. The contract was delayed and the contractor requires 6 weeks lead time to order supplies from receipt of the contract. In addition, I imagine we got bumped on the line of jobs since the contract was delayed. I am hopeful for a start in October or November, weather permitting.

The Annual Priest Convocation will take place this week from Tuesday through Thursday. This is an annual meeting held outside the Diocese with all the priests and the bishop. It comprises meetings, lectures, spiritual exercises and leisure time as well as fraternity. Both Fr. RJ and I will be away. While the Bishop authorizes Communion Services for this week, we are able to have daily Mass uninterrupted thanks to our weekend assistants. Mass will take place each day at 8:30 am. We will return on Friday.

I have been summoned to Federal Jury Duty Selection beginning September 11 through September 22 so I may be away for some time depending on Jury selection. I will keep you posted. It seems that Labor Day marks the end of summer but the summer weather has returned with a vengeance! Stay cool!

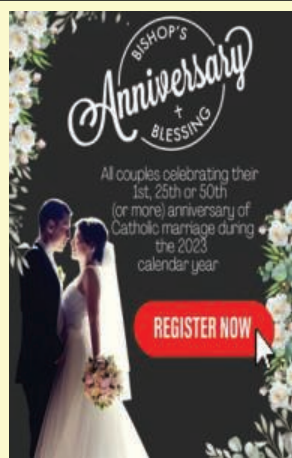

You can access PCS through the parish office who can help you complete and will send in a short referral form to get it started. A PCS coordinator will contact you to arrange for counseling after clarifying more about what you are looking for. So, if you are struggling, reach out now.

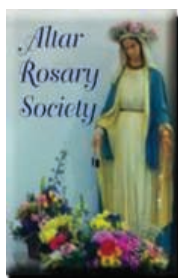
