Dear Parish Family,

Work on the seal coating of the parking lot was completed last Tuesday along with restriping of the parking lot. This was a big job. It did not rain for over a month, but rained 3 times during the seal coating! We had few funerals before we started the seal coating, then we were back to our regular 3 a week, which meant work could not begin until 11:30am. Murphy's law. The same issues prevailed on having sections of tile repaired on the outside of the Church. The tile work was done by volunteers.

The week of September 23<sup>rd</sup>, electrical work will begin in the Church. On Holy Thursday, March 28<sup>th</sup>, a power surge blew out our lighting control panel, which was on hospice before the strike! We lost light just before the Mass of the Lord's Supper. The electricians responded at 6am on Good Friday, and were able to reroute everything to a breaker temporarily. Now we will undertake installing a new lighting control panel. There will be no lights in the Church from Monday, September 23<sup>rd</sup> through Wednesday, September 24<sup>th</sup>. Therefore, any funerals coming in that week will be in Gonzaga Hall. Gonzaga Hall is set up with classrooms, but we still have plenty of room for funeral seating. If the funeral is large, say over 125 people, it would have to be moved to another area Church. We will do our best during those three days. This is, of course, all tentative until the work commences, and may be moved a day or two depending on unforeseen issues.

Several calls were received in the parish office concerning the health of Msgr. Joe, who moved in the spring to a Continuing Care Community in Denville. Msgr. Joe is alive, and well, enjoying his second retirement. I speak to him from time to time. He did get a laugh when I told him the rumor! He is kept busy saying Mass for the other residents, and anointing those in the hospice unit of his community. Msgr. Joe, approaching 90, no longer drives long distances, and avoids the Parkway and Turnpike entirely. While many folks have invited him to significant life celebrations over the last several months, he is unable to come due to the distance and his time commitments where he now lives. He sends his greetings, and well wishes to everyone, and is thankful for your prayers and concern.

This past week myself, Fr. R.J., and the other priests of the Diocese, gathered with our Bishop David M. O'Connell in Galloway Township for the annual Convocation of Priests of the Diocese of Trenton on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday. This is the largest gathering of our priests each year, and combines retreat, meetings, and fraternity. One day we offer Mass for the priests and bishops of the Diocese who have died, and expressly for those who died since the last convocation. Each year the Bishop authorizes Communion Services in place of daily Mass throughout the Diocese so that all the priests can be present. While it is getting harder and harder to find priests, we are blessed that Fr. Jim McDevitt was able to cover the Masses and any funerals during our absence, so a big thank you to him.



In the Catholic Church, the anointing of the sick is a sacrament that is administered to a Catholic "who, having reached the age of reason, begins to be in danger due to sickness or old age". There is no need to wait until a person is at the point of death to receive the Sacrament. The Sacrament may be received at any time during a person's illness, especially before

surgery or treatment. We suggest calling to receive the Sacrament *before* a person is in grave danger of death as it is not always possible to have a priest available at the actual time of death. If you would like to schedule the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick for a loved one, please contact the parish office.
