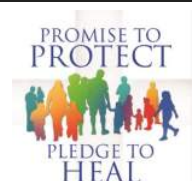

Dear Parish Family,

On September 7th, Pope Leo raised two Blesseds to Sainthood, Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati and Blessed Carlo Acutis, now St. PierGiorgio Frassati and St. Carlo Acutis. Interestingly, both young men were from Northern Italy: St Pier Giorgio Frassati from Turin, and St. Carlo Acutis from Milan, Italy, but from two different eras. They are both models for youth in our time and for all time.

St. Frassati, a young adult who loved athletics, died at age 24 from polio. He was deeply invested in his faith, which led him to a life of action and passion for Social Justice. He was a lay member of the third order of St. Dominic, a member of the St. Vincent de Paul Society, and Catholic Action. At the time of his beatification, Pope St. John Paul II called him the “man of the eight Beatitudes”.

St. Carlo Acutis died in 2006 at the age of 15 from leukemia; he is the first millennial saint. He has been fashioned as “God’s Influencer”. His mother attended the dedication of the Diocesan Shrine of St. Carlo Acutis at St. Dominic’s Church in Brick, where the priests had the opportunity to have breakfast with her and our Bishop. She spoke of her son’s passion for the Eucharist and how he brought her back to the practice of the Catholic Faith. His relics are kept in Assisi, and his mother keeps an apartment nearby. St. Carlo Acutis was a computer programmer who loved technology. He used it to promote the Most Holy Eucharist and evangelize other youth, earning him the title “God’s Influencer”.

In July, the Vatican hosted over 1000 “Catholic Influencer Missionaries”. These are social media content creators who are tackling Christianity’s so-called “branding problem” head-on by leveraging platforms like TikTok and Instagram to spread a relatable and human representation of the Gospel in a digital world. This meeting in July built upon the Vatican’s past recognition of digital platforms as “true mission territory,” by welcoming the Catholic voices who are carrying the Gospel beyond parish walls into digital spaces. At the meeting, Sr. Nathalie Becquart, XMCJ, undersecretary for the Synod of Bishops, stressed to content creators that they ought to remain part of “a pastoral team, a missionary team with your local church” to help guide them and form them, fostering deeper spiritual maturity. The Church has the opportunity, through influencer evangelization, to not only reach farther than ever before with the Gospel and welcome new believers into communion, but also to walk alongside the influencers whose voices and witness reached them first. By influencers strengthening their own formation, cultivating authentic relationships, and fostering trust through shared mission, digital creativity can become a path to encounter, discipleship, and co-responsible participation in parish life and leadership.

St. Carlo Acutis, in 15 years of his life, sparked this fire that now burns and is transforming once unreachable parts of our world for Christ! A new image of St. Carlo was unveiled in Assisi before his canonization, depicting him at the foot of the cross of Christ, dressed in jeans and sneakers, with a backpack and an open laptop! This demonstrates to us how creativity and the methods available in our own era can become means of evangelization and the spread of the Gospel.
