Dear Parish Family,

The Diocesan Co-Chairs for the Synod Ms. Mary Lou Ivins and Deacon Patrick Brannigan have written to all the pastors asking each parish to appoint three lay people to serve as assistants to the Pastor during the Synod process at the parish level, this is especially necessary during the listening sessions.

The Diocese Synod Co-Chairs also announced training sessions set for this month for pastors and pastoral workers that will be in-person and two zoom sessions for December in preparation for the January/February start of the wider Synod process in the Diocese of Trenton.

The Co-Chairs wrote to all the pastors reminding them the Holy Father Pope Francis wants this to be the widest possible consultation. They wrote, "All the people of God – pastors, folks in the pews even those who no longer sit in the those pews – are being called to listen and reflect on each other's experiences, joys and sorrows in their *journey* with the Church."

The Synod Co-Chairs proposed two questions Pope Francis has specifically asked we focus on:

1. *How is this journeying together happening today in our parishes?*
2. *What steps does the Spirit invite us to take to grow in journeying together?*

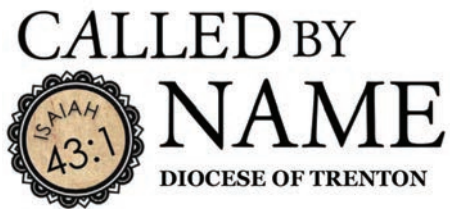
I invite all of us to begin to pray over these two questions in the coming months, jot down a few notes of what comes to you in prayer as you ask the Holy Spirit to guide you in answering these questions and be prepared to offer those reflections when the listening sessions are scheduled. Cut those two questions above out of the bulletin and put them on your refrigerator, bathroom mirror, inside your prayer book, on your night stand or next to your favorite chair.

Also I invite you to give those two questions to those who do not read the bulletin or come to Mass and invite them to reflect on them and be prepared to come to a listening session to offer their reflections.

Most of the time in our world we lament that we don't get a say in things, that we don't matter somehow. Pope Francis has clearly said you matter, your prayerful opinion matters and he wants to hear from you. He is giving you a say!!! Don't squander the opportunity to be part of the largest consultation in the history of humanity!!

Happy Thanksgiving to everyone, remember to count your blessings for if you do you will find they are infinite!

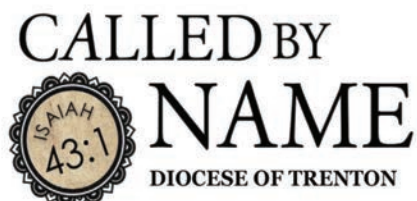

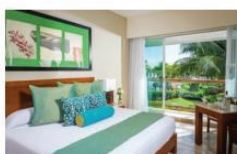
