Dear Parish Family-

Each year during Advent and Lent we order Magnificat Reflection Books and all year round we have an online parish subscription to "Formed" which is available to all parishioners. We have now added to these two options "Hallow". For the next three months the Hallow app will be available to all parishioners without charge. There are two large banners in the Gathering Space of the Church where you can download the app and it is also available in this week's bulletin on page 3, on our website, in our office and the Religious Educations Office. All of these printed and online Catholic sites are a means to assist you in developing your faith, deepening your prayer life and assisting you in spiritual growth. I hope you will make good use of one or all of them.

The Hallow app came about as a result of suggestions made during the Parish phase of the Synod on Synodality; it was suggested the parish try to appeal to younger members through more modern means. Since young people are digital natives, apps like Hallow and Formed are more appealing. Hallow is also a pretty graphic-intensive app, which appeals to younger people. That being said, the content is appealing to everyone.

Hallow offers daily reflections on the Gospel, an inspirational quote of the day, Rosary, Novena's, Divine Mercy Chaplet, Ignatian Spirituality, music, saint of the day, trivia and so much more. It is great if you are in the car, at home or work as it is audio intensive so you can listen and multi-task! Or not.

I am asked from time to time about memorials and I often draw a blank. However, we are offering some ways to memorialize a loved one. Several Liturgical items are being made by a fabric artist for the Church. They are a Lenten Altar Cloth (already taken), a matching Lenten Chasuble, an Ordinary Time Chasuble and two Angel Banners for the Sanctuary. They vary in cost, please see me or call the parish office to speak with either Pat or Sherri. The Angel banners will be for this Christmas so if you are considering them please let me know ASAP. A family may want to share the cost for the memorial and this is certainly possible.

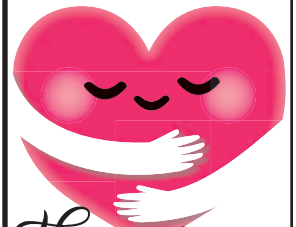
