Dear Parish Family-

We continue to move forward aware the pandemic is still prevalent among us. As U.S. States begin to open we are seeing a rise in virus transmission, in some places a dramatic rise. We must all be vigilant in keeping the safe social distance of Six Feet and wearing Masks in public.

The Obligation to attend Mass is still suspended, you are not required to attend Mass, if you chose to come to Church our regular Sunday Schedule is in effect Saturday 5pm, Sunday 7am, 8:30am, 10:30am and 12:30pm. All Masses are Live Streamed and two weekend Masses are archived for viewing at other times of the day as well.

Use only the two center doors for entering and exiting the building, kindly follow the directions of the volunteers. The rear parking lot behind the cafeteria is closed and there is no access to the building from that lot, park only in the main parking lot using the main two center doors.

Masks and 6 feet of distance are required. Only those pews marked with Green Tape can be used. There is no access to candles, Holy Water, Statues etc. Please do not access any areas marked with Red. While there will be music there will be no congregational singing as this spreads the virus rapidly. Bathrooms are available for emergencies only, kindly go before you come and after you leave. Holy Communion will be distributed AFTER Mass and only in the center aisle, depart by the side aisles. Please depart the property immediately after reception of Communion and avoid congregating in groups inside or outside the buildings. Gathering in any size group is the primary way the virus spreads. Those who are in the high risk category are asked to make use of the Live Stream and not attend in person.

There are no scheduled confessions. Individuals who would like to go to confession must make an appointment. Confessions will be conducted outdoors wearing masks, 6 feet of distance and a barrier between priest and Penitent.

Baptisms, we are asking only for the parents, child to be baptized, siblings of child to be baptized, godparents and grandparents to be present. It is important to keep as few people for the safety of the new born child.

Wedding and Funerals have a grand total of 50 people allowed, this includes music people, photographers, priest etc. Every human person who is alive in the room is counted for the 50 allowed by law, this is an inclusive number. Remember the larger the crowd gathered the greater the chance of virus spread. If we are notified in advance both funerals and weddings can be Live Streamed. For funerals, limit is one per day at the fixed time of 10:30am. There are no wakes as these are not permitted by the State.

1 am providing you with the total attendance numbers from last weekend so you can make an informed decision about risk as to whether you would like the option of attending Mass in person. For the weekend of June 13-14 the following were the number of parishioners who came for Mass;Saturday 5pm – 50 people, Sunday 7am – 60 people, Sunday 8:30am – 63 people, Sunday 10:30am – 63 people, Sunday 12:30pm – 25 people. To these totals you can then add 2 priests, 3 volunteers (except 7am) and 2 music people (except 7am).

The Mass Schedule may be modified in the future for a variety of reasons.

Daily Mass remains at the Pandemic time of 9am and is Live Streamed. The Daily average is 30 people Tues-Thurs. Monday and Fridays the average total is 40 people. Add two priests to these numbers for grand total of persons in the Church.

Whatever decisions you make stay safe and healthy! It was good to see real human beings at all the Masses and hear responses to the prayers and equally edifying to see the large number of people who attend safely and without risk via Live Stream!! We are all praying our way through this terrible pandemic together!

Finally, thank you to all those who are able to continue to support the parish whether its online giving, mail, drop off or Sunday Collection. Thank you for keeping the Spirit of our Community alive and healthy as well!
