Dear Parish Family-

Many of you enjoyed the Cornell University Bird survey I shared. I received quite a few e-mails and comments about my being a Raven. It seems Edgar Allen Poe has given the poor Raven a bad reputation. I share with you a few noble things about the humble and common raven (Corvidae family).

In the Bible we find the following places where the Raven is mentioned: Genesis 8:7, Leviticus 11:15, Deuteronomy 14:14, Psalm 147:9, Psalm 57:4, Proverbs 30:17 Song of Songs 5:11, Isaiah 34:11, Zephaniah 2:14, Job 38:41, 1King 17:2 & 4. In the Gospel of St. Luke 12:24 Jesus uses the raven as an example of the love God has for us.

The Raven is only one of two animals specifically named on the Ark and while we all remember the Dove it was in fact the second bird released, the first bird released to find land was the Raven.

God sent the Raven to care and feed Elijah the Prophet when he was starving.

St. Anthony the Desert father and St. Paul the Hermit of Thebes were both fed by Ravens in their need.

St. Benedict of Nursia, the Father of monasticism, was saved from being poisoned by a Raven sent by God.

A Hermit of St. Meinrad was murdered by thieves and a huge flock of ravens chased them through the paths announcing the crime they had committed.

Ravens are the most intelligent of birds they can speak, create tools, complete complex tasks, recognize faces and are capable of warning people who are in danger.

In Native American Religions they are considered divinely sacred birds, close to God. In some creation stories they are the creators of the world or bring light into the world.

In Norse mythology the god Odin has two Ravens one who sees for him and one who listens for him whom he sends out each day across the world for information.

In Greek Mythology they are associated with the god Apollo and connected with prophecy.

If you have ever visited the Tower of London you know there are always two ravens in the tower, according to legend if the ravens leave the tower England will fall.

In short, they are not as bad as many think. Divine, Messengers, providers, protectors, prophets, talkers, tool makers, listeners, and warning systems. Not bad for a bird....oh and did I mention they are the most intelligent of birds?

At the end of the day, I like their color – Black - it matches my wardrobe! BBM! Black Birds Matter! These are but a few facts about a wonderfully misunderstood bird.
